AWARD DESCRIPTION

- Criminal Justice Certificate Programs: \$500 per term, with total amount of award not to exceed \$1,500.
- Associate of Applied Science or Advanced Start Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, Associate of Applied Science or Advanced Start Bachelor of Science in Fire Science, and Advanced Start Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Management Programs: \$500 per term, with total amount of award not to exceed \$4,500.
- Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, Bachelor of Science in Fire Science, and Bachelor of Science in Fire and Emergency Management Programs: \$500 per course per quarter, with total amount of award not to exceed \$8,500.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO QUALIFY FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE, FIRE SCIENCE, AND EMERGENCY SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be a first-time enrollee in a certificate or degree program offered through Kaplan University.*
- Must meet all current Kaplan University admissions requirements, including GED or high school equivalent, and be fully accepted into one of the Kaplan University online undergraduate criminal justice, fire science, or emergency management degree or certificate programs.
- Must have at least one year of full-time experience working in the criminal justice, fire science, or emergency management field.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Criminal Justice, Fire Science, and Emergency Services Scholarship application must be provided at or before the time of enrollment.
- All additional documents must be provided prior to the fourth week of the first term. If all additional documents are not provided to Kaplan University prior to the fourth week of the first term, the student is not eligible for the Kaplan University Criminal Justice, Fire Science, and Emergency Services Scholarship and will be responsible for the total cost of tuition for enrollment per Kaplan University policy.
- Must take a minimum of two courses per term and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other Kaplan University discount, voucher, grant, or scholarship.

CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY

- If approved, the scholarship will be granted at the time of initial enrollment and credited at the rate of \$500 per term until the funds awarded have been depleted or the student loses eligibility.
- Must be continuously enrolled; withdrawing from school will result in ineligibility.
- If a student fails and retakes a course, scholarship money will not be re-awarded for that course.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants who do not meet the Scholarship eligibility criteria will be informed via email.
