Tuition Information

Application Fee

A \$20 nonrefundable application fee is required with the application and is good for up to two selected class starts within a year's time.

Late Registration Fee

A \$20 late fee will be due at the time of registration for those students registering after the registration period.

Tuition Rate

Tuition is charged on a course-by-course basis at the rate of \$230 per quarter credit hour.

Technology Fee

Each term, a \$210 technology fee will be charged to each student attending class. There is no refund of the technology fee once the student has attended any course.

Background Investigation Fee

A background check is required for students in the Criminal Justice, Early Childhood Development, Educational Paraprofessional, and Medical Assisting programs. Cost for the background check is \$75.

Course Fees

The following courses have additional fees (quarter credit programs). There is no refund of course fees once the student has attended the course.

Additional Fees

Travel Agent Proficiency (TAP) Examination \$100

Tuition Due Dates

All tuition and fees are due and payable the week before classes start. Exceptions are allowed when loans and grants are processing.

Total debt upon graduation will vary depending on students' eligibility for grant aid, and their ability to make any cash payments during their course of study to lower their borrowing needs. Typically a student who makes no payments while in school will graduate with between \$2,000 and \$11,000 in student loans after completing a certificate program and between \$7,000 and \$17,000 after completing an associate's degree.
