AWARD DESCRIPTION

\$500 per term, with total amount of award not to exceed \$8,500.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO QUALIFY FOR THE PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP

- Must be a first-time enrollee in a bachelor's degree program at Kaplan University; continuing students are not eligible.
- Must meet all current Kaplan University admissions requirements including GED or high school equivalent, and be fully accepted into one of the Kaplan University online bachelor's or advanced start degree programs.
- Must be a verifiable member of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society of the Two-Year College at a previously attended institution of higher education.*

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All application materials and proof of eligibility must be provided on or before the time of enrollment. If all of the application materials and proof of eligibility are not provided to Kaplan University on or before the time of enrollment, the student is not eligible for the Kaplan University Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship and will be responsible for the total cost of tuition for enrollment per Kaplan University policy.
- Must take a minimum of two courses per term and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other Kaplan University discount, voucher, grant, or scholarship.

CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY

- If approved, the scholarship will be granted at the time of initial enrollment and credited at the rate of \$500 per term until the funds awarded have been depleted or the student loses eligibility.
- Must be continuously enrolled; withdrawing from school will result in ineligibility.
- If a student fails and retakes a course, scholarship money will not be re-awarded for that course.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants who do not meet the Scholarship eligibility criteria will be informed via email.
