\*\*A nonrefundable application fee is due at the time the enrollment agreement is signed: \$20 fee for undergraduate programs; \$45 fee for graduate programs.

- Students who are pursuing a **Dental Assistant Diploma and taking more than 14 credit hours per term** will be charged the term cost of \$4830, plus \$352 per credit hour beyond the 14 credits. Students who are enrolled in **fewer than 12 credit hours** will be charged the number of quarter credit hours per term times \$352.
- Students who are pursuing the **Practical Nursing 1240 Diploma program and taking more than 19 credit hours per term**, will be charged the term cost of \$4682, plus \$335 per credit hour beyond the 19 credits. Students who are enrolled in **fewer than 14 credit hours** in the Practical Nursing 1240 Diploma program will be charged the number of quarter credit hours per term times \$335.
- Students who are pursuing the **Associate in Nursing Degree program and taking more than 18 credit hours per term**, will be charged the term cost of \$5109 plus \$405 per credit hour beyond the 18 credits. Students who are enrolled in **fewer than 12 credit hours** in the Associate in Nursing program will be charged the number of quarter credit hours per term times \$405.
- Students who are pursuing a **certificate or associates program and taking more than 16 credit hours per term** will be charged the term cost of \$5109 plus \$405 per credit hour beyond the 16 credits. Students who are enrolled in **fewer than 12 credit hours** in a certificate, associate or bachelor's program will be charged the number of quarter credit hours per term times \$405.
- Students who are pursuing a **BS and taking more than 18 credit hours per term**, will be charged the term cost of \$5109, plus \$405 per credit hour beyond the 18 credits.
- Students who are pursuing the Master of Business Administration or in the Master of Science in Management will be charged \$441 per credit hour.
- Students who are pursuing the Master of Health Care Administration will be charged \$420 per credit hour.
- Students who are pursuing in the Master of Science Information Technology will be charged \$402 per credit hour.
- Students who are pursuing the following programs (Master of Science in Criminal Justice, Master of Science in Fire and Emergency Services, Master of Science in Homeland Security and Emergency Management and Master of Public Health) will be charged \$385 per credit hour.
- Students who are pursuing the following programs (Master of Public Administration, Master of Science in Environmental Policy and Master of Science in Psychology) will be charged \$368 per credit hour.

\*\*\*Total cost of tuition is based on the recommended sequence of classes and credits per term with no deviations from that recommended sequence, and at the current rate of tuition. This amount is also based on program requirements, and can change if a student decides to pursue a different program. Student can be subject to additional charges for repeating failed classes. The term tuition rates are subject to change. Notice of an increase in tuition will be provided 30 days prior to the start of a new term.

**Instructional Material for Practical Nursing 1240 Diploma:**

In addition to the tuition cost per term, students must purchase the textbooks, supplies and other instructional material (the "Instructional Material") each term as may be required for the Practical Nursing Diploma program course work for such term. The Instructional Material can be purchased from the campus bookstore or through other sources. The cost per term for the Instructional Material varies based on the Instructional Material required for each individual term. The estimated cost of Instructional Material per program for a full-time student is \$1385.

**Instructional Material for Associate of Science in Nursing:**

In addition to the tuition cost, students must purchase textbooks, supplies and other instructional material (the "Instructional Material") each term as may be required for the Associate of Science in Nursing program course work for such term. The Instructional Material can be purchased from the campus bookstore or through other sources. The cost per term for the Instructional Material varies based on the Instructional Material required for each individual term. The estimated cost of instructional Material per program for a full-time student is approximately \$2300 (\$2225 for textbooks and \$75 for other supplies (scrubs, watch, bandages, hemostat, stethoscope, etc.)

**Graduate Programs:**

All students are required to pay a \$100.00 technology fee each term. For the MBA, MSM and MSIT, this fee is prorated to \$50 per six-week term. Books and other instructional materials are not included in the program tuition.

**Master of Business Administration Program Fees:**

Master of Business Administration students will pay one-time fees of \$84.50 as part of GB 500 (\$64.50 for Insights Discovery profile and \$20.00 for Marketplace Business Simulation) and \$40.00 as part of GB 601 (Marketplace Business Simulation).

**Master of Science in Management Program Fees:**

Master of Science in Management students will pay a one-time fee of \$64.50 prior to the start of GM 500 (Insights Discovery Profile).

**Other Programs:**

Students enrolled in academic programs other than master's degrees, Practical Nursing or the Associate of Science in Nursing will receive textbooks as part of tuition costs. Students may purchase supplemental course materials at a retail price pre-determined by campus administration. Course materials loaned to students must be returned at the end of each term in good condition. Please see the campus bookstore for details regarding book and course material distribution and purchasing policies.

**Transportation Fees (Omaha campus):**

In addition to the tuition cost, students have the option to purchase Metro Area Transit (MAT) bus line tickets directly from the campus. A 30 Day Unlimited Ride Bus tickets through MAT can be charged to a student's account at a rate of \$45 each.
